When Austria got annexed by Nazi-Germany in 1938, Bruno Kreisky had to flee to Sweden, because he was a socialist and Jew. It took Kreisky more than ten years, to get back to Austria.

After the return of Bruno Kreisky to Austria, President **Kim Il Sung** still took care on him. He sent him regularly medicine to Austria, including a Korean medic.
